Out There in the WORLD OF KIDS

Young Life is custom made for kids throughout their adolescent years. Young Life is also the term we use for our program with high school students, while we call our middle school program WyldLife. Our program for college and university students is called Young Life College.

Young Life's multicultural ministry, focused on kids of color and kids from under-resourced communities, is arguably the largest of its kind in the United States. We refer to our ministry to kids with disabilities as Capernaum and to our work with teen moms as YoungLives. In a partnership with Military Community Youth Ministries, Young Life reaches military teens through a program called Club Beyond. The Small Towns initiative brings Young Life to communities of fewer than 25,000 people.

In addition to our ministries here in the United States, Young Life is in more than 50 countries, reaching nearly a million kids each year with the life-changing message of God's love for them.
